ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

23. The requirements for the various programmes are as follows:
 - a. **Master's Degree:** Candidates applying for the part-time programmes must possess a Bachelor degree with a minimum of Second-Class Honours (Lower Division). Candidates with Third Class degree or Higher National Diploma must also possess a Postgraduate Diploma at credit level in a related discipline from any recognised University to be eligible for admission. HND candidates must possess a minimum of Lower Credit to apply.
 - b. **PGD Programmes:** Candidates applying for the Postgraduate Diploma programme must possess a minimum of Third-Class Bachelor's degree from the Nigerian Defence Academy or any other recognised University, or Higher National Diploma at a minimum of Lower Credit.

DURATION OF PROGRAMME

24. The duration of professional programmes are as follows:
 - a. A student for Master degree shall pursue the programme for 18 months (2 semesters course work and 1 semester for project) and 24 months (3 semesters course work and 1 semester for project).
 - b. A student for Postgraduate diploma shall pursue the programme for twelve months (2 semesters) except engineering courses which runs for 24 months (4 semesters).

GENERAL INFORMATION

25. Professional master degree and postgraduate diploma Programmes are delivered on Fridays and Saturdays.
26. The Academy reserves the right to step down any programme prior to commencement without notice.
